



CERTIFICATE IN BIBLICAL COUNSELLING (CBC)

10 Classes. 20 Credit-Hours. One-year full time.

Purpose: To prepare students to care effectively for others in the Body of Christ.

Description: The one-year certificate (full-time equivalent) introduces the student to the biblical theory and practice of the one-another ministry of caring for hurting and struggling people. This course will give the student increased confidence in using their counselling skills to encourage others in faith and hope.

Enrolment Requirements: Students must be able to read, research, and write at a university level.

Cost: There is no cost to enrol. Students should consult the website for individual class fees.

Length of study: One-year full-time, five years part-time.

Pathways: Student can upgrade to the two-year Certificate in Pastoral Counselling (CPC). Those with a first degree may enrol in the Master of Arts in Biblical Counselling (MABC).
