CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY (CCM)

20 Classes. 40 Credit-Hours. Two-years full time.

Purpose: To train ministry leaders and volunteers for effective and competent gospel work.

Description: This two-year certificate (full-time) advances the student to an intermediate level understanding of biblical and theological concepts, disciplines, and information. Further study gives the student confidence in using their ministry skills. The heart as well as the head is the focus of the study.

Enrolment Requirements: Students must be able to read, research, and write at a university level.

Cost: There is no cost to enrol. Students should consult the website for individual class fees.

Length of study: Two-years full-time, six-years part-time.

Pathways: Student may upgrade to the Certificate in Pastoral Ministry (CPM). Students with an existing degree may enrol in the Birmingham Theological Seminary *Master of Biblical Studies*.
