

CERTIFICATE IN PASTORAL MINISTRY (CPM)

30 Classes. 60 Credit-Hours. Three-years full time.

Purpose: To train men for effective and skilled pastoral leadership.

Description: This three-year certificate (full-time) advances the student to an advanced level understanding of biblical and theological concepts, disciplines, and information. The heart as well as the head is the focus of the study. Successful completion of the CPM will fulfil the ordination requirements of most churches.

Enrolment Requirements: Students must be able to read, research, and write at a university level.

Cost: There is no cost to enrol. Students should consult the website for individual class fees.

Length of study: Three-years full-time, seven-years part-time.

Pathways: Graduate students may cross-credit to the Birmingham Theological Seminary Master of Arts in Ministry
